Amendment No. 1 to House Bill No. 1038.

Amend House Bill No. 1038 as originally introduced:

Page 6, line 1, add the following new paragraph:

(k) Other elected law enforcement officials who by nature of their office may function as a law enforcement officer shall have minimum standards for training before fulfilling law enforcement responsibilities, and shall be required to attend The Basic Police Training Course. Each of these officials shall meet all the criteria set forth in Arkansas Code 12-9-106, and Regulation 1002, Minimum Standards for Employment or Appointment, The Rules and Regulations Manual, The Commission on Law Enforcement Standards and Training. If any of these officials do not comply with these requirements, they shall not take any action as a law enforcement officer.
