Amendment No. 2 to House Bill No. 1046.

Amend House Bill No. 1046 as originally introduced:

Page 1, line 9, delete "ESTABLISH AN" and substitute "ESTABLISH"

AND

Page 1, line 9, delete CONFIDENTIAL" and substitute 'CONFIDENTIALITY"

AND

Page 1, line 10, delete "PRIVILEGE"

AND

Page 1, line 14, delete "AN"

AND

Page 1, line 15, delete "CONFIDENTIAL PRIVILEGE" and substitute "CONFIDENTIALITY"

AND

Page 1, delete line 30 and substitute:

"(A) Has at least thirty (30) hours of specialized domestic violence training in assisting victims of"

AND

Page 2, line 15, delete "A victim" and substitute "Unless a court orders the disclosure of the confidential communications, a victim"

AND

- Page 2, delete line 19 and substitute:
 - "(2) The confidential communications shall be those made"

AND

- Page 2, delete line 22 and substitute:
- "(c) Unless required to disclose the confidential communications by court order finding just cause, the confidential communications may be claimed by: "

AND

- Page 2, delete line 24 and substitute:
- "(2) A guardian or conservator of the victim unless the guardian or conservator is the alleged perpetrator; "

AND

Page 2, line 28, add:

"(d) If a domestic abuse advocate has reasonable cause to suspect child maltreatment or that the child has died as a result of child maltreatment, or who observes a child being subjected to conditions or circumstances which would reasonably result in child maltreatment, the domestic abuse advocate shall immediately notify the child abuse hotline."
