## Amendment No. 1 to House Bill No. 1064.

Amend House Bill No. 1064 as originally introduced:

Page 1, delete lines 9 through 14 and substitute: "AN ACT TO REPEAL ARKANSAS CODE 29-30-162 AND 29-30-163; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

AND

Page 1, delete lines 17 through 20 and substitute: "TO REPEAL ARKANSAS CODE 29-30-162 AND 29-30-163."

## AND

Delete everything after the enacting clause and substitute: "SECTION 1 Arkansas Code 29-30-162 is repealed. § 29-30-162. Amendment of expiration date Acts 1997, No. 1135, §2. Subsection (b) of Section 2 of Act 1135 of 1997 is amended to read as follows: "(b) The provisions of this section shall expire on April 30, 2002."

SECTION 2. Arkansas Code 29-30-163 is repealed. § 29-30-163. Expiration date of Acts 1999, No. 1268. The provisions of this act shall expire on April 30, 2002."
