Amendment No. 1 to House Bill No. 1072.

Amend House Bill No. 1072 as originally introduced:

Page 1, delete line 23 and substitute:

SECTION 1. Intent. [THE ARKANSAS CODE REVISION COMMISSION IS NOT
REQUIRED TO CODIFY THIS SECTION.]

It is the belief of the General Assembly that the United States was
founded on the principals recited in the Declaration of Independence and that
these principals formed the core of our political belief and that it is
important to pass these core beliefs onto future generations.

SECTION 2. Arkansas Code Title 6, Chapter 16, Subchapter 1 is amended"

AND

Page 1, delete lines 26 and 27 and substitute:

"Teachers in public schools may conduct, at any point during school
hours, an oral recitation of the following"
