Amendment No. 1 to House Bill No. 1105.

Amend House Bill No. 1105 as originally introduced:

Delete the Title and substitute the following:

"AN ACT TO PROVIDE MEDICAID COVERAGE FOR PERSONS AGED SIXTY-FIVE (65) AND OVER WITH ASSETS UP TO FOUR THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$4,000) FOR A SINGLE INDIVIDUAL AND SIX THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$6,000) FOR A MARRIED COUPLE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

AND

Delete the Subtitle and substitute the following: "AN ACT TO PROVIDE MEDICAID COVERAGE FOR PERSONS AGED SIXTY-FIVE (65) AND OVER WITH ASSETS UP TO FOUR THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$4,000) FOR A SINGLE INDIVIDUAL AND SIX THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$6,000) FOR A MARRIED COUPLE."

AND

Page 1, delete lines 33 through 36 and substitute the following: "SECTION 2. <u>If funds become available, the Department of Human</u> <u>Services shall raise the resource eligibility limit for persons sixty-five</u> (65) and over to four thousand dollars (\$4,000) for a single individual and <u>six thousand dollars (\$6,000) for a married couple.</u>"
