Page 2, delete line 6 delete and substitute the following "adjusted and fastened seat belt whenever the school bus is so equipped. (d) The state, county, a school district, school bus operator, or agent or employee of a school district or school bus operator, including a teacher or volunteer serving as a chaperone, shall not be liable in any action for personal injury by a school bus passenger for an injury caused solely by another passenger's use or non-use of a safety belt or restraint system in a dangerous or unsafe manner."
Page 2, delete line 12 and substitute the following: "with three-point retractable seat belts on every seat."
