Subtitle of House Bill No. 1134

"AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE USE OF SEAT BELTS ON SCHOOL BUSES WHEN
AVAILABLE; TO REQUIRE THAT SCHOOL BUSES PURCHASED AFTER JANUARY 1,
2002 BE EQUIPPED WITH SEAT BELTS."

Amendment No. 3 to House Bill No. 1134.

Amend House Bill No. 1134 as originally introduced:

Adding Representatives Cleveland, Magnus, Bookout, Bradford, T. Steele,
Napper, and Moore

AND

Page 2, delete line 6 and substitute the following:

"adjusted and fastened seat belt whenever the school bus is so equipped.

(d) The state, county, a school district, school bus operator, or agent or employee of a school district or school bus operator, including a teacher or volunteer serving as a chaperone, shall not be liable in any action for personal injury by a school bus passenger for an injury caused solely by another passenger's use or non-use of a safety belt or restraint system in a dangerous or unsafe manner."

AND

Page 2, delete line 12 and substitute the following:

"with three-point retractable seat belts on every seat."

AND

Page 2, line 11, delete "January 1, 2002" and substitute "January 1, 2003"

AND

Page 2, delete lines 13 through 15
