"TO REQUIRE COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTION COMMISSIONERS TO POST SIGNS
NEAR THE DRIVEWAY ENTRANCES OF POLLING SITES TO GIVE NOTICE OF THE
POLLING SITE."

Amendment No. 2 to House Bill No. 1175.

Amend House Bill No. 1175 as engrossed, H1/23/01:

Add Representative Rackley as a cosponsor to the bill

AND

Page 1, line 10, delete "DRIVEWAY" and substitute "DRIVEWAY"

AND

Page 2, delete lines 6 through 8 and substitute:

"(3)(A) On the day of a general, special, or runoff election, the county board shall post a double-sided sign that is at least four-square feet in size near each main driveway entrance to the polling site on each"

AND

Page 2, delete lines 11 through 18 and substitute:

"(i) State "VOTE HERE" at each polling site;
(ii) Contain an arrow pointing to the polling site;
(iii) Be placed as close as possible to the public street without obstructing traffic; and
(iv) Be visible to all traffic approaching the polling site."
