DEATH PENALTY."

Amendment No. 1 to House Bill No. 1264.

Amend House Bill No. 1264 as originally introduced:

Page 2, delete lines 30 through 36, and substitute the following:

"human life; or

(10) The capital murder was committed against a person whom the defendant knew or reasonably should have known was especially vulnerable to the attack because:

(A) ~~of~~ of either a temporary or permanent severe physical or mental disability which would interfere with the victim's ability to flee or to defend himself; or

(B) The person was twelve (12) years of age or younger."
