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**Subtitle of House Bill No. 1319**

"TO MAKE TECHNICAL AND ADMINISTRATIVE CORRECTIONS THAT AFFECT THE  
DISTRIBUTION OF INSURANCE PREMIUM TAXES USED FOR LOCAL POLICE AND  
FIRE PENSION FUNDS."

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**Amendment No. 1 to House Bill No. 1319.**

Amend House Bill No. 1319 as originally introduced:

Page 2, line 34, delete "subchapter" and substitute "section"

AND

Page 3, line 1, delete "section" and substitute "section and then to general revenues"

AND

Page 3, line 27, delete "subchapter" and substitute "section"

AND

Page 3, line 28, delete "Fund" and substitute "Fund and then to general revenues"

AND

Page 5, line 14, add the following:

"SECTION 10. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the provisions of this act must be implemented before the funds described herein are next disbursed in order to insure the fiscal well-being of the beneficiaries of the Police and Fire Pension and Relief Funds. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall become effective on the date of its approval by the Governor. If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last

house overrides the veto."
