"AN ACT TO AMEND THE INSURANCE CODE AND WORKER'S COMPENSATION LAW
TO GIVE INVESTIGATORS FULL LAW ENFORCEMENT POWERS."

Amendment No. 1 to House Bill No. 1361.

Amend House Bill No. 1361 as originally introduced:

Page 1, delete lines 10 and 11 and substitute
"COMPENSATION LAW TO GIVE INVESTIGATORS SPECIALIZED LAW ENFORCEMENT POWERS;
AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

AND

Page 1, delete line 16 and substitute
"INVESTIGATORS SPECIALIZED LAW ENFORCEMENT"

AND

Page 1, delete lines 28 through 34 and substitute
"(i) The Commissioner shall designate the personnel assigned to the Workers' Compensation Fraud Investigation Unit, who, upon meeting the qualifications established by the Arkansas Commission on Law Enforcement Standards and Training, shall have the powers of specialized law enforcement officers of the State of Arkansas for the purpose of conducting investigations under § 11-9-106(d)(1)(B). Personnel hired as specialized law enforcement officers shall have a minimum of three (3) years of law enforcement experience."

AND

Page 2, delete lines 7 through 13 and substitute
"(3) The Commissioner shall designate the personnel assigned to the Insurance Fraud Investigation Division, who, upon meeting the qualifications established by the Arkansas Commission on Law Enforcement Standards and Training, shall have the powers of specialized law enforcement officers of the State of Arkansas for the purpose of conducting investigations under § 23-66-504, and any criminal violations related to those
