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## Amendment No. 1 to House Bill No. 1440.

Amend House Bill No. 1440 as originally introduced:

Page 1, delete lines 12 & 13 and substitute:

"MADE TO ARKANSAS CUSTOMERS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

AND

Page 1, delete lines 20 & 21 and substitute:

"MADE TO ARKANSAS CUSTOMERS."

AND

Page 2, delete line 2 and substitute:

"the internet or other electronic ordering process, or the processing of orders by non-electronic means, by mail order, fax, telephone, or otherwise, does not relieve a vendor"

AND

Page 2, delete line 16 and substitute:

"267 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as in effect on January 1, 2001,"

and

Page 2, line 19, add a new section as follows:

"SECTION 2. <u>Effective Date.</u> [THE ARKANSAS CODE REVISION COMMISSION IS NOT REQUIRED TO CODIFY THIS SECTION.] <u>The provisions of this act shall be</u> effective on and after January 1, 2002.
