Amend House Bill No. 1607 as originally introduced: Page 1, delete lines 15, 16, and 17 and substitute the following: "KATIE'S LAW." Page 1, delete lines 22 through 28 and substitute the following: "SECTION 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as "Katie's Law". When any sexual offense, as defined by Arkansas Code 5-14-101 through 123, is committed against any person, who, at the time of the sexual offense, was traveling within this state by private motor vehicle, common carrier, watercraft, or other mode of transportation, and it is impossible to determine the county in which the sexual offense was committed, the venue for prosecuting the person committing the sexual offense may be in any county of this state from, through, or to which the victim traveled."
