Amendment No. 1 to House Bill No. 1664.

Amend House Bill No. 1664 as originally introduced:

Add Representative R. Smith as a cosponsor to the bill

AND

Page 5, line 24, insert:

"SECTION 6. <u>EMERGENCY CLAUSE.</u> It is found and determined by the <u>General Assembly that in order to efficiently reimburse the counties for the</u> <u>homestead property tax credit, county assessors are required to recertify to</u> <u>the Chief Fiscal Officer the amount of real property reduction on or before</u> <u>June 30 of the year 2001 and every year thereafter.</u> Therefore, an emergency is <u>declared to exist and this act being immediately necessary for the</u> <u>preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall become effective on</u> <u>the date of its approval by the Governor.</u> If the bill is neither approved nor <u>vetoed by the Governor, it shall become effective on the expiration of the</u> <u>period of time during which the Governor may veto the bill.</u> If the bill is <u>vetoed by the Governor and the veto is overridden, it shall become effective</u> <u>on the date the last house overrides the veto.</u>
