Subtitle of House Bill No. 1664

"TO AMEND THE PROPERTY LAWS TO CLARIFY THE PROCEDURES FOR CLAIMING
A THREE HUNDRED DOLLAR PROPERTY TAX CREDIT."

Amendment No. 1 to House Bill No. 1664.

Amend House Bill No. 1664 as originally introduced:

Add Representative R. Smith as a cosponsor to the bill

AND

Page 5, line 24, insert:

"SECTION 6. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly that in order to efficiently reimburse the counties for the homestead property tax credit, county assessors are required to recertify to the Chief Fiscal Officer the amount of real property reduction on or before June 30 of the year 2001 and every year thereafter. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall become effective on the date of its approval by the Governor. If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house overrides the veto.
