- "(4) After completion of the testing, the firearms shall be returned to the law enforcement agencies.
- (5) Within three (3) working days after completion of the testing, the State Crime Laboratory shall send to the law enforcement agency from which it received the weapon, notice that the testing has been completed.
- (6) When the law enforcement agency regains possession of the firearm, the law enforcement agency shall immediately notify the owner, unless the owner is prohibited by law from possessing the firearm, that the owner may regain possession of the firearm at the offices of the law enforcement agency. "
