Subtitle of House Bill No. 1865

"AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTION APPROPRIATION FOR THE 2001-
2003 BIENNIUM."

Amendment No. 5 to House Bill No. 1865.

Amend House Bill No. 1865 as engrossed, 4/10/01:

Add a new section immediately after Section 40 to read as follows:

"SECTION 40. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. JAIL CONTRACTS/REIMBURSEMENTS FUNDING PROVISION. During the 2001-03 biennium the Department of Correction shall, at a minimum, budget to expend for Jail Contracts/Reimbursements, 2.7% of the "A" Allocation and 20% of the "B" Allocation of general revenues distributed through the Revenue Stabilization Law to the Department of Correction Inmate Care and Custody Fund Account during the 2001-02 fiscal year; and an amount of not less than the amount required by this provision for the 2001-02 fiscal year, plus 20% of the "B" Allocation of general revenues distributed through the Revenue Stabilization Law to the Department of Correction Inmate Care and Custody Fund Account during the during the 2002-03 fiscal year.

In the event the amount of moneys invoiced during either fiscal year to the Department of Correction for Jail Contracts/Reimbursements is less than the minimum amounts required by this section, the Department of Correction shall certify to the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State the actual amount of moneys necessary each fiscal year to meet its Jail Contracts/Reimbursements payment obligation to the counties. Upon approval by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and review by the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee, the Department of Correction may revise the amount of funding allocated and budgeted for Jail Contracts/Reimbursements to the actual amount as certified and approved by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and reviewed by the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee."

Renumber the subsequent sections of the bill.
