Amendment No. 4 to House Bill No. 1882.
Amend House Bill No. 1882 as engrossed, S4/3/01:
Page 5, delete lines 2 through 5 and substitute the following: "(b)(1) At the time the order creating the district is made, the State Board of Education shall appoint a board of seven (7) members for the new district to serve until the next regular election of members, when a board of directors shall be elected in compliance with Arkansas law. (2) Following the entry of the order creating the new district and the appointment of a board of directors for the new district, but prior to the transfer of any assets, territory, property, liabilities, duties or responsibilities, any new district created by detachment from an existing district that is a party to any court ordered desegregation plan shall petition the court having jurisdiction in the desegregation matter and obtain any and all court orders or other relief necessary to insure that the detachment will not cause the state or any affected school district to be in violation of any orders of the court or any consent consent orders or decrees entered into by the parties with regard to the desegregation plan."
