## Amendment No. 1 to House Bill No. 1971.

Amend House Bill No. 1971 as originally introduced:

Add Senator Hill as a Senate cosponsor to the bill

AND

Page 4, line 25 insert:

"SECTION 4. <u>EMERGENCY CLAUSE.</u> It is found and determined by the <u>General Assembly that property tax reimbursements to the counties will most</u> <u>likely begin in April and it is critical to the counties to account for costs</u> <u>borne by the certification of amounts of real property tax reduction to the</u> <u>Chief Fiscal Officer of the State as soon as possible.</u> Therefore, an <u>emergency is declared to exist and this act being immediately necessary for</u> <u>the preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall become</u> <u>effective on the date of its approval by the Governor. If the bill is</u> <u>neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become effective on the</u> <u>expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the bill.</u> <u>If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is overridden, it shall</u> <u>become effective on the date the last house overrides the veto.</u>"
