Subtitle of House Bill No. 2265

"TO MAKE IT UNLAWFUL TO DIVERT FOR PERSONAL OR COMMERCIAL USE ANY
RECYCLABLE MATERIALS PLACED IN RECYCLING CONTAINERS."

Amendment No. 1 to House Bill No. 2265.

Amend House Bill No. 2265 as originally introduced:

Page 1, line 25, delete "5-36-101." and substitute "5-36-120."

AND

Page 1, delete lines 30 through 32 and substitute the following:

"(2)(A) For a first offense under this subsection (a), a person shall be issued a citation which shall be a warning citation and no court appearance shall be required or penalty shall be imposed by the court.

(B) A record of each warning citation issued shall be maintained and for the second or a subsequent offense, an offender shall be subject to the penalties prescribed.

(3) Any person who pleads guilty or nolo contendere to or is found guilty of violating this subsection (a) for a second or a subsequent offense shall be guilty of a Class C misdemeanor.
