Subtitle of House Bill No. 2345

"AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE LONG-TERM CARE FACILITIES TO REDISTRIBUTE
THROUGH CHARITABLE ORGANIZATIONS THE PRESCRIPTION MEDICINES OF
DECEASED RESIDENTS."

Amendment No. 1 to House Bill No. 2345.

Amend House Bill No. 2345 as originally introduced:

Add Representative Borhauer as a cosponsor of the bill

AND

Add Senator Hunter as a cosponsor of the bill

AND

Page 1, line 24 delete "(a)" and substitute "(a)(1)"

AND

Page 1, delete line 28 and substitute the following:
"package.

(2) Medicines shall not be transferred under this act until at least five (5) days after the coroner has been notified of the resident's death.

(3)(A) The charitable organization shall notify the recipient of the medicines that the medicines are recycled; and

(B) The recipient of the medicine shall acknowledge in writing that they have been notified that the medicines are recycled.

(4) The long-term care facility shall, within forty-five (45) days of the death of a resident who receives cycle-fill medicines, notify the pharmacy which supplies each cycle-fill medicine."

AND

Page 2, line 9, add the following:

"(3) Manufacturers, wholesalers, pharmacists and pharmacies shall not be liable for any civil damages arising from any defects or

alterations of medicines occurring after the medicines have left the custody or control of the entity."
