## Subtitle of House Bill No. 2375

"AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 6-17-807 PERTANING TO PAYMENT TO TEACHERS FOR ADDITIONAL CONTRACT DAYS."

## Amendment No. 1 to House Bill No. 2375.

Amend House Bill No. 2375 as originally introduced:

Insert an additional section immediately following Section 1 to read as follows:

"SECTION 2. <u>EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the</u> General Assembly that under present law, schools are unable to contract with certified personnel for summer work at a rate of pay of less than the normal contract wage; that such restriction is inequitable; that this act will allow school districts to contract summer work at a negotiated rate; and that this act should go into effect as soon as possible in order for it to be effective during the coming summer. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall become effective on the date of its approval by the Governor. If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house overrides the veto."
