**Subtitle of House Bill No. 2510**

"AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 27-51-210 TO INCREASE THE SPEED AT  
WHICH A VEHICLE TOWING A MANUFACTURED HOME MAY DRIVE."

**Amendment No. 1 to House Bill No. 2510.**

Amend House Bill No. 2510 as originally introduced:

Add Representative Mack as a co-sponsor of the bill

AND

Page 1, delete lines 25 through 27 and substitute:

"(a) No person shall drive a vehicle which is towing a ~~house trailer~~  
manufactured home or mobile home at a speed greater than ~~a maximum of forty-~~  
~~five (45) fifty-five (55)~~ miles per hour.

(b) On roads upon which the posted speed limit is less than fifty-five  
(55) miles per hour, the posted speed limit shall be observed.

(c) The Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department may set  
minimum and maximum speed limits different than those posted, or may set a  
speed limit less than the maximum provided in subsections (a) and (b), for a  
vehicle towing a manufactured home or mobile home by noting any speed  
restriction on the oversize load permit issued by the department to that  
vehicle."
