## Amendment No. 1 to House Bill No. 2523.

Amend House Bill No. 2523 as originally introduced:

Page 1, line 35, add the following:

"SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly that certain Arkansas public trusts with lands from military reservations have made requests for services from municipalities under Act 779 of 1999; that the availability of municipal utility services and infrastructure is critical to the development plans for those public trusts; that those public trusts must preserve the current law under Act 779 to meet their needs to fulfill development plans for infrastructure needed to support development of the former military reservation lands; and that it is necessary for this act to have immediate effect to preserve the current state of law under Act 779 for these kinds of entities. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall become effective on the date of its approval by the Governor. If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house overrides the veto."
