Amendment No. 1 to House Bill No. 2528.

Amend House Bill No. 2528 as originally introduced:

Delete the Title and substitute the following:
"AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH TO ESTABLISH THE KIDS-FOR-HEALTH
PROGRAM; TO PROVIDE FOR IN-SCHOOL HEALTH PROGRAMS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

AND

Delete the Subtitle and substitute the following:
"AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH TO ESTABLISH THE KIDS-"

AND

Page 1, delete line 27 through 29 and substitute the following:

"SECTION 1. The Department of Health shall use moneys from The Tobacco
Settlement Proceeds Act to establish a Kids-for-Health program."

AND

Page 1, line 36 delete "state-wide"

AND

Page 2, delete lines 2 and 3 and substitute the following: "apply for grants to design and implement local Kids-For-Health AND

Page 2, line 9, delete "(b)" and substitute "(b)(1)"

And

Page 2, line 13, add the following:

"(2) Each school district may design a Kids-For Health program appropriate to that district, but each Kids-for Health program shall include, study of general health issues, study of tobacco and drug abuse prevention and cessation, direct student involvement in health-related activities, attention to self-esteem, body systems and functions, nutrition and fitness, hygiene and safety, community health, and pre-testing and post-testing to determine the effectiveness of the local program."
