SECTION 3. Arkansas Code 7-2-104 is amended to read as follows: 7-2-104. Third Congressional District.

The Third Congressional District shall be composed of the counties of: Baxter, Benton, Boone, Carroll, Crawford, Franklin, Howard, Little River, Johnson, Logan, Madison, Marion, Newton, Polk, Pope, Scott, Sebastian, Sevier, and Washington; and the qualified electors residing therein shall elect one (1) member of the House of Representatives of the United States.

SECTION 4. Arkansas Code 7-2-105 is amended to read as follows: 7-2-105. Fourth Congressional District.

The Fourth Congressional District shall be composed of the counties of: Arkansas, Ashley, Bradley, Calhoun, Chicot, Clark, Cleveland, Columbia, Dallas, Desha, Drew, Garland, Grant, Hempstead, Hot Spring, Howard, Jefferson, Lafayette, Little River, Lee, Lincoln, Miller, Monroe, Montgomery, Nevada, Ouachita, Phillips, Pike, Sevier, St. Francis, and Union; and the
