Subtitle of House Bill No. 2600

"AN ACT TO ESTABLISH THE CONGRESSIONAL DISTRICTS IN ARKANSAS."

Amendment No. 1 to House Bill No. 2600.

Amend House Bill No. 2600 as originally introduced:

Delete everything after the enacting clause and substitute:

SECTION 2. Arkansas Code 7-2-102 is amended to read as follows:

7-2-102. First Congressional District.

The First Congressional District shall be composed of the counties of: ~~Arkansas,~~ Baxter, Boone, Clay, Cleburne, Craighead, Crittenden, Cross, Fulton, Greene, Independence, IZARD, Jackson, Lawrence, ~~Lee,~~ Lonoke, Marion, Mississippi, ~~Monroe, Phillips,~~ Newton, Prairie, Poinsett, Randolph, St. Francis, Searcy, Sharp, Stone, Van Buren, and Woodruff; and the qualified electors residing therein shall elect one (1) member of the House of Representatives of the United States.

SECTION 3. Arkansas Code 7-2-103 is amended to read as follows:

7-2-103. Second Congressional District.

The Second Congressional District shall be composed of the counties of: Conway, Faulkner, Grant, Perry, Pulaski, Saline, ~~Van Buren,~~ White, and Yell; and the qualified electors residing therein shall elect one (1) member of the House of Representatives of the United States.

SECTION 4. Arkansas Code 7-2-104 is amended to read as follows:

7-2-104. Third Congressional District.

The Third Congressional District shall be composed of the counties of: ~~Baxter,~~ Benton, ~~Boone,~~ Carroll, Crawford, Franklin, Johnson, Logan, Madison, ~~Marion, Newton,~~ Polk, Pope, Sebastian, Scott, and Washington; and the qualified electors residing therein shall elect one (1) member of the House of Representatives of the United States.

SECTION 5. Arkansas Code 7-2-105 is amended to read as follows:

7-2-105. Fourth Congressional District.

The Fourth Congressional District shall be composed of the counties of: Arkansas, Ashley, Bradley, Calhoun, Chicot, Clark, Cleveland, Columbia, Dallas, Desha, Drew, Garland, ~~Grant,~~ Hempstead, Hot Spring, Howard, Jefferson, Lafayette, Lee, Little River, Lincoln, Miller, Monroe, Montgomery, Nevada, Ouachita, Phillips, Pike, Sevier, and Union; and the qualified

electors residing therein shall elect one (1) member of the House of Representatives of the United States."
