Subtitle of House Bill No. 2620

"AN ACT TO INCREASE THE PENALTIES FOR THE CRIMINAL OFFENSE OF DRIVING
WHILE INTOXICATED WHICH RESULTS IN DEATH OR BODILY INJURIES."

Amendment No. 1 to House Bill No. 2620.

Amend House Bill No. 2620 as originally introduced:

Page 1, delete lines 9 through 11 and substitute
"AN ACT TO CREATE THE CRIMINAL OFFENSE OF AGGRAVATED ASSAULT BY VEHICLE; AND
FOR OTHER PURPOSES. "

AND

Page 1, delete lines 14 through 17 and substitute
"AN ACT TO CREATE THE CRIMINAL OFFENSE OF AGGRAVATED ASSAULT BY VEHICLE"

AND

Page 1, delete everything after the Enacting Clause and substitute
"SECTION 1. (a) A person commits aggravated assault by vehicle if the
person negligently causes serious bodily injury to another person as a result
of operating a vehicle, an aircraft, or a watercraft:

(1) While intoxicated as defined by Arkansas Code 5-65-102; or
(2) If at that time there is an alcohol concentration of eight-
hundredths (0.08) or more in the person's breath or blood based upon the
definition of breath, blood and urine concentration in Arkansas Code 5-65-
204.

(b) As used in this section, "serious bodily injury" means any bodily
injury which creates a substantial risk of death or which causes serious,
permanent disfigurement or protracted loss or impairment of the function of
any bodily member or organ.

(c) Aggravated assault by vehicle is a Class D felony."
