Subtitle of House Bill No. 2648

"TO ESTABLISH THE PROCEDURE FOR COUNTING UNDER-VOTES, OVER-VOTES,
AND DISQUALIFIED VOTES AND TO ESTABLISH DEADLINES FOR THE COUNTING
OF ALL VOTES."

Amendment No. 1 to House Bill No. 2648.

Amend House Bill No. 2648 as originally introduced:

Page 1, line 9, delete "COUNTING" and substitute "REVIEWING"

AND

Page 1, line 11, delete "COUNTING" and substitute "REVIEWING"

AND

Page 1, line 15, delete "COUNTING" and substitute "REVIEWING"

AND

Page 1, line 18, delete "COUNTING" and substitute "REVIEWING"

AND

Delete everything after the enacting clause and substitute:

"SECTION 1. (a) At the time it certifies the vote to the Secretary of State, the county board of election commissioners shall report to the state board of election commissioners the total number of:

- (1) Ballots printed and delivered to the polls;
- (2) Challenged ballots that were disqualified;
- (3) Spoiled ballots; and
- (4) Unused ballots.

(b) Within thirty (30) calendar days after any election, the county board of election commissioners shall report to the state board of election commissioners the number of over-votes and under-votes cast in the election."
