**Amendment No. 3 to Senate Bill No. 11.**

Amend Senate Bill No. 11 as engrossed, S2/01/01:

Page 1, delete lines 9 through 12 and substitute "AN ACT TO ESTABLISH THE OFFENSE OF COMMUNICATING A DEATH THREAT CONCERNING A SCHOOL EMPLOYEE OR STUDENT; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES. "

AND

Page 1, delete lines 15 through 19 and substitute "TO ESTABLISH THE OFFENSE OF COMMUNICATING A DEATH THREAT CONCERNING A SCHOOL EMPLOYEE OR STUDENT. "

AND

Page 1, delete lines 24 through 36 and substitute:

"SECTION 1. (a) A person commits the offense of communicating a death threat concerning a school employee or student if:

(1) The person communicates to any other person a threat to cause the death of a school employee or student;

(2) The threat involves the use of a firearm or other deadly weapon;

(3) A reasonable person would believe the person making the threat intends to carry out the threat;

(4) There is a close temporal relationship between the threatened act and the substantial step; and

(5) The person making the threat purposely engaged in conduct that constitutes a substantial step in a course of conduct intended to culminate in the commission of the threatened act.

(b) Conduct is not a substantial step under this section unless it is strongly corroborative of the person's criminal purpose.

(c) Communicating a death threat concerning a school employee or
