Amend Senate Bill No. 13 as originally introduced:
Page 1, delete lines 28 through 32 and substitute: "(2)(A) If the court utilizes prospective juror questionnaires, the questionnaires shall not request the prospective jurors' mailing or residential address or phone number. (B) The attorney for the parties shall be precluded from asking for that information during voir dire. (C) However, the attorney or court may ask prospective jurors their city or town of residence. (3) Nothing in this section shall preclude the clerk of the court from keeping and maintaining records of potential jurors that contain mailing or residential addresses or phone numbers."
