"AN ACT TO REPEAL ARKANSAS CODE 16-90-121 REQUIRING A MINIMUM TEN
YEAR SENTENCE FOR PERSONS COMMITTING A FELONY INVOLVING THE USE OF A
DEADLY WEAPON."

Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill No. 190.

Amend Senate Bill No. 190 as originally introduced:

Page 1, delete lines 9 through 12 and substitute
"AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 16-90-121 CONCERNING A MINIMUM TEN YEAR
SENTENCE FOR PERSONS COMMITTING A SECOND OR SUBSEQUENT FELONY INVOLVING THE
USE OF A FIREARM; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES. "

AND

Page 1, delete lines 15 through 18 and substitute
"AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 16-90-121 CONCERNING A MINIMUM TEN YEAR
SENTENCE FOR PERSONS COMMITTING A SECOND OR SUBSEQUENT FELONY INVOLVING THE
USE OF A FIREARM. "

AND

Delete everything after the Enacting Clause and substitute
"SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 16-90-121 is amended to read as follows:

16-90-121. Felony Second or subsequent felony with deadly weapon
firearm.

Any person who is found pleads guilty of or pleads, nolo contendere to,
or is found guilty to of a second or subsequent felony involving the use of a
deadly weapon firearm, whether or not an element of the crime, shall be
sentenced to serve a minimum term of imprisonment of ten (10) years in the
state prison without eligibility of parole or community punishment transfer
but subject to reduction by meritorious good-time credit."
