## Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill No. 190.

Amend Senate Bill No. 190 as originally introduced:

Page 1, delete lines 9 through 12 and substitute "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 16-90-121 CONCERNING A MINIMUM TEN YEAR SENTENCE FOR PERSONS COMMITTING A SECOND OR SUBSEQUENT FELONY INVOLVING THE USE OF A FIREARM; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

AND

Page 1, delete lines 15 through 18 and substitute "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 16-90-121 CONCERNING A MINIMUM TEN YEAR SENTENCE FOR PERSONS COMMITTING A SECOND OR SUBSEQUENT FELONY INVOLVING THE USE OF A FIREARM."

## AND

Delete everything after the Enacting Clause and substitute

"SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 16-90-121 is amended to read as follows:.

16-90-121. Felony <u>Second or subsequent felony</u> with deadly weapon firearm.

Any person who is found <u>pleads</u> guilty of or <u>pleads</u>, <u>nolo</u> contendere to, <u>or is found</u> guilty to of a <u>second or subsequent</u> felony involving the use of a <u>deadly weapon</u> firearm, whether or not an element of the crime, shall be sentenced to <del>serve</del> a minimum <u>term of imprisonment</u> of ten (10) years in the state prison without <u>eligibility of</u> parole <u>or community punishment transfer</u> but subject to reduction by meritorious good-time credit."
