**Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill No. 213.**

Amend Senate Bill No. 213 as originally introduced:

Page 3, line 15, add an additional section to read as follows:

"SECTION 8. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that in order for technology incentives to be more readily available to Arkansas students meeting Committed to Education Foundation program criteria, the immediate passage of this act is required. The proceeds resulting from sales of Committed to Education license plates is critical to ensuring the timely reward and recognition of these outstanding elementary students and immediate passage of this act allows the program to implemented and administered without delay. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall become effective on the date of its approval by the Governor. If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house overrides the veto.
