Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill No. 253. Amend Senate Bill No. 253 as originally introduced: Page 1, delete lines 10, 11 and 12 in the Title and substitute the following: "AN ACT TO ALLOW A CHECK OF THE MOTOR VEHICLE FOR SEAT BELT COMPLIANCE, BUT PROHIBITS POLICE FROM SEARCHING THE VEHICLE, DRIVER, OR PASSENGERS BEYOND THE SEAT BELT CHECK; TO"; Page 1, delete lines 18, 19, 20 and 21 in the Subtitle and substitute the following: "TO ALLOW A SEAT BELT CHECK OF THE MOTOR VEHICLE, BUT PROHIBIT POLICE FROM SEARCHING THE VEHICLE OR PASSENGERS BEYOND THE SEAT BELT CHECK; PROHIBIT THE USE"; Page 1, delete lines 29 through 34 and substitute the following: "27-37-704. Inspection for compliance only. No motor vehicle, nor the operator of such vehicle, nor the passengers of such vehicle shall be stopped, inspected, or detained solely to determine compliance with this subchapter. (a) A motor vehicle may be stopped and the driver and passengers inspected for compliance with this subchapter. (b) However, a law enforcement officer shall not search or inspect a motor vehicle, its contents, the driver, or a passenger except for the check of compliance with this subchapter.".
