"AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 19-11-222 RELATING TO THE JURISDICTION OF THE STATE PROCUREMENT DIRECTOR.

Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill No. 457.

Amend Senate Bill No. 457 as originally introduced:

Insert an additional section immediately following SECTION 1 to read as follows:

"SECTION 2. <u>EMERGENCY CLAUSE.</u> It is found and determined by the <u>General Assembly that this measure is necessary to clarify the state's</u> <u>purchasing law and to prevent disruptions in the orderly conduct of business</u> <u>by agencies of the state.</u> Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and <u>this act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public</u> <u>peace, health and safety shall become effective on the date of its approval</u> <u>by the Governor.</u> If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, <u>it shall become effective on the expiration of the period of time during</u> <u>which the Governor may veto the bill.</u> If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last <u>house overrides the veto.</u>"
