## Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill No. 528.

Amend Senate Bill No. 528 as originally introduced:

Page 1, delete lines 26 and 27 and substitute: "or shipping of  $\mathbf{a}$ :

- (A) A business' own products which the business wholesales to retail businesses or ships to its own retail outlets;
- (B) Products owned by other companies with which the business has contracts for storage and shipping if seventy-five percent (75%) of the sales revenue is from out-of-state customers; or
- (C) Products for sale to the general public if seventy-five percent (75%) of the sales revenue is from out-of-state customers;"

AND

Page 2, line 9, delete "sixty percent (60%)" and substitute "sixty percent (60%) seventy-five percent (75%)"

AND

Page 2, line 14, delete "sixty percent (60%)" and substitute "sixty percent (60%)" seventy-five percent (75%)"

AND

Page 2, delete line 20 and substitute:

"public, unless seventy-five percent (75%) of the sales revenue is from outof-state customers;"

AND

Page 2, delete lines 30 and 31 and substitute:

"telemarketing, claims processing, and other administrative functions  $\underline{\text{that}}$  act as production centers;"

AND

Page 4, delete line 23 and substitute: "subject to payment in full.

- SECTION 3. Arkansas Code 26-52-705, concerning qualifications for economic investment tax credits, is amended by adding an additional subsection to read as follows:
- (e)(1) If project costs exceed the initial project cost estimate included in the financial incentive plan, the business shall amend the financial incentive plan to include updated cost figures.
- (2) Amendments that exceed fifty percent (50%) of the original financial incentive plan estimate shall be submitted as a new project.
- (3) An amendment shall not change the start date of the original project."
