Page 2, delete lines 10 though 14 and substitute the following: "election which shall be held three (3) weeks from the day on which the general election is held. The special runoff election shall be conducted in the same manner as is now provided by law, and the election results thereof shall be canvassed and certified in the manner provided by law."

Delete Sections 10, 11, 12, and 13 of the bill
AND
Appropriately renumber the sections of the bill
