Subtitle of Senate Bill No. 800

"AN ACT TO REQUIRE UNIFORM PRESCRIPTION DRUG INFORMATION CARDS."

Amendment No. 3 to Senate Bill No. 800.

Amend Senate Bill No. 800 as engrossed, S3/6/01:

Page 4, delete line 7 and substitute the following:

"SECTION 6. (a) This act does not require a health benefit plan that"

AND

Page 4, delete line 11 and substitute the following:

"technology contains all of the required fields of information established by the National Council for Prescription Drug Programs, as in effect January 1, 2001, that are necessary to process a claim for prescription drug benefits under the health benefit plan.

(b) The required fields of information shall be included on the card in a substantially similar format to that established by the National Council for Prescription Drug Programs, as in effect January 1, 2001, and shall be printed in a clear, readable and understandable manner."

AND

Page 4, delete SECTION 7 in its entirety and substitute the following:

"SECTION 7. All prescription drug information cards, or other technologies, including dual use identification cards described in Section 6 of this act, that are executed, delivered, issued, modified, extended or renewed by a health benefit plan shall comply with the requirements of this act within two (2) years after the effective date of this act."

AND

Page 4, delete lines 26 through 30 and substitute the following:

"SECTION 8. The State Insurance Commissioner shall have all the powers to enforce this act"
