**Subtitle of Senate Bill No. 807**

**Amendment No. 2 to Senate Bill No. 807.**

Amend Senate Bill No. 807 as engrossed, S3/14/01:

Page 3, delete line 32 and substitute the following:

"(3)(A) The policy may provide that computers and electronic equipment first be offered"

AND

Page 3, delete line 35 and substitute the following:

"(B) The policy may provide that computers be secondarily"

AND

Page 4, delete lines 26 through 34 and substitute the following:

"(a) If an agency policy established under Section 4 of this act provides for the preferential sale of surplus computer and electronic equipment to agency employees, that computer and electronic equipment shall be sold at a price not less than ten percent (10%) above depreciated value as determined by the Department of Finance and Administration.

(b) If an agency policy established under Section 4 of this act provides for the preferential sale of surplus computer and electronic equipment to Arkansas public schools, that computer and electronic equipment shall be sold at a price not less than five percent (5%) above depreciated value as determined by the Department of Finance and Administration.

SECTION 7. Surplus equipment not sold.

(a) Unsold surplus computer and electronic equipment may be donated by the owning agency to Arkansas Public Schools if the agency policy so provides."
