Amend Senate Bill No. 815 as engrossed, S3/07/01:
"Com Long Model
"Services Model. (3)(A) In that the State has included in its Medicaid State Plan
filed with the Health Care Financing Administration two (2) service models
serving individuals with developmental disabilities, with different
guidelines and funding, the Developmental Disabilities Treatment Clinic
Services and the Child Health Management Services, the latter being a broader
array of services with higher rates only available to children/families in a
small number (25) of communities around the state, the prior authorization
process for the Child Health Management Services model during this moratorium
shall be limited to those day treatment core services included in the child's
individualized treatment plan which exceed a cumulative threshold of five (5)
hours per day until the General Assembly establishes other parameters and
fundi ng.
(B) For other diagnostic and treatment codes under the
Child Health Management Services model, the current promulgated guidelines
establishing limitations on services will be used as the threshold, with
prior authorization being required for services prescribed by the
interdisciplinary team, including the primary care physician, beyond those
limits established in the state's Medicaid guidelines.
(C) The moratorium for prior authorization of all other
community-based services, regardless of funding model, shall be in effect in
keeping with the remaining sections of this act."
