Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill No. 839.

Amend Senate Bill No. 839 as originally introduced:

Page 1, line 36, add an additional Section to read as follows: "SECTION 2. <u>EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the</u> <u>General Assembly that it is necessary to protect employees of the Alexander</u> <u>Youth Center from loss of pay as a result of privatization of the Center; and</u> <u>that in order to provide adequate protection to the employees this act should</u> <u>become effective immediately</u>. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist <u>and this act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public</u> <u>peace, health and safety shall become effective on the date of its approval</u> <u>by the Governor</u>. If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, <u>it shall become effective on the expiration of the period of time during</u> <u>which the Governor may veto the bill</u>. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor <u>and the veto is overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last</u> <u>house overrides the veto.</u>"
