Amendment No. 1 _ to Senate Bill No. 89.

Amend Senate Bill No. 89 as originally introduced:

Page 1, delete lines 26 through 30 and substitute the following:
"shall be enhanced if the property is:
(A) A generator intended for use by:
<u>(i) A public facility;</u>
<u>(ii) A nursing home or hospital;</u>
<u>(iii) An airport;</u>
<u>(iv) A public safety device;</u>
<u>(v) A communication tower or facility;</u>
<u>(vi) A public utility;</u>
(vii) A water system or sewer system;
(viii) A public safety agency; or
(ix) Other facilities or uses providing a vital
<u>servi ce; or</u>
(B) Any other equipment used in the transmission of
<u>electric power or telephone service.</u>
(2) For the purpose of this subsection (c):
(A) "Public safety agency" means an agency of the State of
Arkansas or a functional division of a political subdivision which provides
<u>fire fighting and rescue, natural or man-caused disaster or major emergency</u>
response, law enforcement, and ambulance or emergency medical services; and
(B) "Public safety device" includes but shall not be
<u>limited to a traffic signaling device or railroad crossing device.</u>
(3) The penalty shall be enhanced as follows:
(A) The fine for the offense shall be at least five
thousand dollars (\$5,000) and not more than fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000).
The fine shall be mandatory; and
