Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill No. 897.
Amend Senate Bill No. 897 as originally introduced:
Page 5, delete lines 2 through 9 and substitute "(2)(A) A citizen shall be permitted to copy public records with his or her own equipment unless the copying would threaten the security or integrity of the records or, in the case of electronic records, the computer system. (B) Copying by a citizen shall: (i) Not damage the record in any way; (ii) Take place only when the record is in the control of the custodian; and (iii) Be subject to the custodian's supervision. (C) If a citizen is not allowed to use his or her own copying equipment, the custodian shall provide a copy of the record at no charge."

Page 8, delete line 15 and 16 and substitute "(4) All opinions, decisions, and orders made in the adjudication of contested materials, and"
