HANDLING FOOD."

Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill No. 929.

Amend Senate Bill No. 929 as originally introduced:

as originally introduced

Page 1, delete lines 20 through 22 and substitute the following:

"SECTION 1. (a) Employees of food service establishments shall keep their hands and exposed portions of their arms clean.

(b)(1) Except when washing fruits and vegetables, employees of food service establishments may not contact exposed, ready-to-eat food with their bare hands and shall use suitable utensils such as deli tissue, spatulas, tongs, single-use gloves, or dispensing equipment.

(2) Employees shall minimize bare hand and arm contact with exposed food that is not in a ready-to-eat form."

Page 1, line 23 delete "(b)" and substitute "(c)"
