AND

Delete the Subtitle and substitute the following:

"AN ACT TO ENSURE PROPER FOOD SAFETY. "

AND

Page 1, delete line 21 and substitute the following:

"their hands and exposed portions of their arms clean in a manner approved by the Department of Health."

AND

Page 1, delete lines 23 through 25 and substitute the following:

"service establishments shall avoid contact of exposed ready-to-eat food with their hands by use of suitable utensils such as deli tissue, spatulas, tongs or single-use gloves; or they shall wash hands and exposed portions of their arms utilizing a handwashing program approved by the department."

AND

Page 1, delete line 28 and substitute the following:

"(c) The department shall, within thirty (30) days after the effective date of this act, initiate a full review of the current version of the United States Food and Drug Administration Model Food Code.
