Subtitle of Senate Bill No. 934

"AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR IMPRISONMENT UP TO SIXTY (60) DAYS FOR DRIVING
ON A SUSPENDED OR REVOKED LICENSE."

Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill No. 934.

Amend Senate Bill No. 934 as originally introduced:

Page 1, delete lines 9 through 11 and substitute:

"AN ACT TO ESTABLISH THE TERM OF IMPRISONMENT FOR VIOLATIONS ASSOCIATED WITH
DRIVER'S LICENSES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

AND

Page 1, delete lines 15 through 17 and substitute:

"TO ESTABLISH THE TERM OF IMPRISONMENT FOR VIOLATIONS ASSOCIATED WITH
DRIVER'S LICENSES. "

AND

Page 1, delete lines 24 and 25 and substitute:

"SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 27-16-301 is amended to read as follows:
27-16-301. Penalty generally.

(a) It is a misdemeanor for any person to violate any of the
provisions of this act unless the violation is by this act or other law of
this state declared to be a felony.

(b) Unless another penalty is in this act or by the laws of this state
provided, every person convicted of a misdemeanor for the violation of any
provision of this act shall be punished by a fine of not more than five
hundred dollars (\$500) or by imprisonment of not more than ninety (90) days.
