Subtitle of Senate Bill No. 966

"TO REQUIRE ENTITIES USING ANY NAME, SYMBOL, OR LOGO OF A STATE
AGENCY OR POLITICAL SUBDIVISION FOR SOLICITING CHARITABLE FUNDS TO
RECEIVE AUTHORIZATION FROM ATTORNEY GENERALS' OFFICE PRIOR TO
SOLICITING FUNDS."

Amendment No. 2 to Senate Bill No. 966.

Amend Senate Bill No. 966 as engrossed, H3/27/01:

Page 1, delete lines 9 through 17 and substitute
"AN ACT CONCERNING THE PUBLIC POLICY OF THIS STATE TO PROTECT CHARITABLE
ENTITIES AND ITS CITIZENS FROM FRAUDULENT SOLICITORS; AND FOR OTHER
PURPOSES. "

AND

Page 1, delete lines 20 through 25 and substitute
"AN ACT CONCERNING THE PUBLIC POLICY OF THIS STATE TO PROTECT CHARITABLE
ENTITIES AND ITS CITIZENS FROM FRAUDULENT SOLICITORS"

AND

Delete everything after the Enacting Clause and substitute
"SECTION 1. It is the public policy of this state to protect
charitable entities and to protect those citizens who would contribute to
charitable entities from fraudulent solicitors.

SECTION 2. Any contract to solicit funds in Arkansas for charitable
purposes that provides for the solicitor to receive compensation based on a
portion or percentage of the funds collected shall be void and unenforceable
if that portion or percentage exceeds twenty-five percent (25%).

SECTION 3. Any person, firm, corporation, partnership, or other entity
who contracts to solicit charitable funds in Arkansas under a contract which
provides for the solicitor to receive compensation based on a portion or
percentage of the funds collected may be enjoined from soliciting funds in
Arkansas for up to two (2) years if that portion or percentage exceeds
twenty-five percent (25%).

SECTION 4. The Office of the Attorney General shall be responsible for the civil enforcement of this act."
