Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill No. 971.

Amend Senate Bill No. 971 as engrossed, S3/16/01:

Page 1, delete lines 34 through 36 and substitute:

"(B) A person may only use the prefix, "Judge," Justice,"
or "Chief Justice" in an election for a judgeship if the person is currently
servng in a judicial position to which the person has been elected."
