Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill No. 98.

Amend Senate Bill No. 98 as originally introduced:

Page 1, delete lines 24 through 36 and page 2, delete lines 1 through 8, and substitute the following:

"SECTION 1. (a) Any judge or justice under the age of seventy (70) years who is receiving retirement benefits under Arkansas Code Title 24, Chapter 8, Subchapter 2 or Subchapter 7, and who is elected or appointed to any judicial office in this state, and who foregoes receipt of retirement benefits while serving in the judicial office shall be entitled to resume receiving his or her previous retirement benefits upon termination of the subsequent service.
